Typical Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Travel in a six-county area assisting admissions with informing the public of the availability of TCAT Crump's programs.
- 2. Interact with the public, students, faculty and staff.
- 3. Distribute promotional materials, set-up and manage display booths at special events like fairs, sporting events, and festivals.
- 4. Answer general questions and provide basic information concerning the college and its programs.
- 5. Assist with college events as needed.
- 6. Assist with general office duties for campus events.
- 7. Perform additional duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1. High school diploma or equivalent
- 2. Ability to plan and prioritize projects.
- 3. Ability to work independently and in groups
- 4. Ability to communicate effectively in written and spoken English with excellent public speaking and presentation skills
- 5. Ability to multi-task
