PART-TIME HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT TECHNOLOGY INSTRUCTOR

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology Crump is accepting applications for the position of a Part-Time Health Information Management Technology Instructor to work evenings and/or Saturdays with evenings being Tuesday/Thursday nights from 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. and Saturdays being one Saturday a month at Henderson, TN and one Saturday a month at Clifton, TN.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Post-secondary education in Health Information Management or related field.
- Certified Medical Coder, AAPC Certified Professional Coder preferred, or ability to obtain professional certification.
- Three years' work experience in the field of medical coding and billing and electronic health record systems or related experience.
- Must possess the organizational and communication skills necessary to be an effective instructor.
- Commitment to utilizing technology in the teaching/learning experience and willingness to stay up-to-date on current and upcoming technology.

General Duties:

- Teach all phases of the Health Information Management Technology Program including: customer service, business communications, medical insurance, electronic health records, medical coding and billing, medical terminology and basic anatomy.
- Monitor, grade, and evaluate student progress and attendance.
- Participate in professional development activities as needed to remain current in the field.
- Other duties include student recordkeeping, and student recruitment, placement.
