

POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT EMT/A-EMT INSTRUCTOR/COORDINATOR

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology Crump is accepting applications for the part-time evening position of EMT/A-EMT Instructor/Coordinator.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1. Associate Degree from a regionally accredited institution and completion of and EMS Board approved Instructor's course.
- 2. Currently licensed as a Tennessee EMT-Paramedic or registered nurse, without history of revocation, denial, or suspension of license.
- 3. Licensed emergency care experience shall include a minimum of two (2) years practice, preferably within the last five (5) years.
- 4. Administrative Experience: Minimum of one (1) year in EMS education administration.
- 5. Meet all requirements of the Tennessee Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Board and be knowledgeable of all current rules and regulations.
- 6. Evidence in instructional program management and supervision, teaching and curriculum building is desired.
- 7. Proficiency in oral and written communication skills. Good oral and written communication skills.
- 8. Must be willing to remain current in the industry.
- 9. Willingness to establish and maintain positive relationships with affiliated clinical partners, business, and industry.
- 10. Ability to complete reports/paperwork and meet all deadlines.

Typical Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Instruct students through lecture, demonstrations, and/or audio-visual aids.
- 2. Curriculum preparation and updates, daily lesson planning, theory, clinical and practical instruction in all phases of the EMT/A-EMT program.
- 3. Prepare syllabi of courses of study with detailed lesson plans.
- 4. Develop clinical partnerships and collaborate with partners to schedule and supervise student training.
- 5. Monitor, grade, and evaluate student progress.
- 6. Source and request necessary instructional equipment and supplies for proper instruction.
- 7. Maintain appropriate student records and submit timely reports.
- 8. Maintain required completion, placement, and licensure rate pursuant to the Council on Occupational Education (COE) accreditation standards.
- 9. Maintain TN EMS Board requirements for first-time licensure pass rates.
- 10. Assist in program recruitment and assist certified graduates with placement opportunities.
- 11. Develop an active Occupational Advisory Committee comprised of professionals in the healthcare profession.

Working Conditions:

- 1. Use of computer
- 2. Normal standing, sitting, and walking
- 3. Must be physically able to lift up to 50 lb., stoop, stand and work, with or without accommodation, to demonstrate and perform all work-based projects.
- 4. Operating a motor vehicle to travel within the college service area and in other areas as needed.

Salary: Commensurate with education, experience and according to TBR salary guidelines.
