



PRACTICAL NURSING (Traditional) TIMELINE 2021-2022

July 6, 2021

Last day to provide a passing HESI test score from another site taken within the last two years for the Fall 2021 Practical Nursing Traditional Program. Classes for this program begin September 1, 2021.

- The Traditional Class meets Monday – Friday 8:00am-2:30pm for 12 months.

July 8-July 13, 2021

The top candidates and four alternates will be notified to pick up formal application packets. *If you are contacted for the wrong class, it is your responsibility to contact Admissions at 731-632-3393 or email adm@tcatcrump.edu.*

July 16, 2021

Deadline to pick up formal application packets from Student Services.

- Offices are open Monday-Friday from 8:00am-4:00pm

August 5, 2021(12:00pm)

Deadline for students to submit all application packet items back to Student Services **except** the drug screen and medical record. The following items **must be received by this date**:

- Nursing Program application / Notice & Release Form
- Acknowledgement / Receipt of Drug & Alcohol Abuse Policy
- Official copies of **ALL** High school transcripts or proof of high school equivalency diploma
- Official copies of **ALL** TCAT, college or university transcripts

The drug screen is done electronically and goes to the Regional Nursing Director. The medical record is done with your doctor and may be brought to orientation for your respective program.

August 6, 2021

Financial Aid applications (2021-2022) Free Application for Federal Student Aid – FAFSA) should be filed by all students planning to participate in the programs and your MyTCAT portal checked for any Tracking Requirements like verification documents to submit. August 18, 2021

- 1) MANDATORY Practical Nursing Orientation at 8:30am – till finished. Lunch will be served.
- 2) Medical Entrance Records are due on this date.

September 1, 2021

FIRST DAY OF CLASS. Any tuition/fees amount not eligible to be covered by a student's financial aid package will be due and payable by cash, check, credit, or debit card before this day. MyTCAT portal has information about student account balances. Balances may be paid in MyTCAT portal with TouchNet online service or in the Business Office at the main campus.
