

POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Facilities Support Associate, Full Time

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology Crump is accepting applications for the full-time, non-exempt position of Facilities Support Associate. This position is based at the Crump Campus under the supervision of the Facilities Coordinator. Due to COVID-19, TCAT Crump has a need for additional facilities and custodial support. Position is contingent upon work and grant funding.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or equivalent. Post-Secondary technical diploma preferred.
- Minimum of two (2) years of experience in maintenance and custodial/housekeeping
- Knowledge of methods and procedures allowing for safe and proper maintenance duties
- Knowledge of the material and equipment used in custodial, grounds-keeping, and building maintenance
- Valid Tennessee Driver's License and ability to drive truck with trailer and operate forklift and other maintenance and grounds equipment

GENERAL DUTIES

- Cleaning, sanitizing, and maintaining assigned areas
- Clean breakrooms, restrooms, hallways, offices, classrooms, and other areas on a routine schedule
- Replenish custodial supplies, such as toilet paper, paper towels, soap, trash bags, etc. as needed
- Perform security functions such as unlocking, locking, and checking doors and windows
- Perform general maintenance and repairs of buildings and equipment
- Maintain campus buildings and immediate grounds
- Ensure that facilities meet environmental, health and safety standards
- Use small hand tools
- Perform tasks related to facilities and grounds upkeep
- Assist in maintaining mechanical and electrical systems or to perform equipment maintenance
- Travel and work at off-campus locations
- Other duties as assigned

SALARY: Commensurate with Tennessee College of Applied Technology salary guidelines

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Must be able to knee lift up to 70 pounds
- Walking or constantly standing, must be able to climb ladders, stairs, bend, stoop, kneel, twist, crouch, crawl; use tools or special devices to work, move, guide, or place objects
- Requires mental and visual attention to detail
- Must be willing to work flexible hours and travel as necessary
