POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT PRACTICAL NURSING INSTRUCTOR – CRUMP CAMPUS

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology Crump is accepting applications for the full-time position of Practical Nursing Instructor to be located at the main campus in Crump, Tennessee.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Associate Degree in Nursing required. Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree preferred
- Must hold active licensure as a Registered Nurse in the State of Tennessee
- Minimum three (3) years of full-time experience in the nursing field within the last five (5) years.
- Minimum three (3) years current clinical nursing experience
- Prior teaching experience preferred

GENERAL DUTIES:

The practical nursing instructor, under the direction of the Coordinator of Nursing, shall be responsible for the following areas including, but not limited to: planning, developing, initiating, and teaching the approved instructional program for practical nursing students in both the classroom and clinical setting; maintaining confidential, accurate and complete records on paper and electronically; providing individual evaluation of each student's progress with counseling and appropriate recommendations when required; supervising students' clinical experiences as scheduled; and maintaining good public relations with clinical partners. The practical nursing instructor will also assist with student placement and student follow-up; participate in recruitment of students; cooperate with outside agencies; work with program advisory committees; conduct visits to related business and industry; and establish and maintain good public relations within the college's service area. Some travel is required. Class hours are Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm. Clinical hours vary.

SALARY: Commensurate with Tennessee College of Applied Technology salary guidelines.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Use of computer
- Normal standing, sitting, and walking
- Must be physically able to lift up to 50 pounds, stoop, stand and work, with or without accommodation, to demonstrate and perform all work-based projects in a classroom and clinical health care setting.
- Operating a motor vehicle to travel within the college service area and in other areas as needed.
